EXPLANATION OF THE GRADING SYSTEM OF A-LEVELS

A-Level stands for Advanced Level and AS Level stands for Advanced Subsidiary Level. An AS Level contains half the content of the corresponding A Leve and is normally completed in one year whilst a full A-Level requires two years.

A-Level examinations are usually taken after 13 years of education (12 at Cambridge International School) and are based on approximately 360 hours of guided learning per subject over a two year period. The Cambridge (CAIE) International A-Level is reported on a grade scale from A* (highest) to E (minimum Requirement to pass). There is no A* grade for Cambridge (CAIE) International AS Levels, which are awarded from grade A to E.

All examinations are set, marked and moderated externally under the oversight of Cambridge Assessment International Education, a department of the University of Cambridge in the United Kingdom.

A-levels are highly specialised and a student will normally take three subjects, although occasionally exceptional students can take four or five. They are a 'gold standard' of international education, and act as entry qualifications for universities across the globe. They are considered equivalent to the level of first year undergraduate study in many universities.


