Spring 2 Term

"What makes our world unique?"

Why?

Learning about our world is important for a multitude of reasons. Firstly, it broadens our understanding of the natural world and helps us appreciate its beauty and complexity. This understanding can inspire us to protect and conserve the environment for future generations. Secondly, it allows us to appreciate the diversity of human culture and fosters empathy and understanding towards people from different backgrounds. Thirdly, learning about our world's history, including its triumphs and mistakes, can help us make more informed decisions about our present and future. Additionally, studying the world can help us develop critical thinking skills and problem-solving – these abilities will be extremely valuable throughout your child's education journey.



7 Weeks: March - April 2025

Science

This term, students will learn about different materials. By the end of this topic, students will be able to name and identify different materials, distinguish between an object and a material, and describe the properties of different materials using appropriate adjectives. Pupils will carry out numerous experiments to research the properties of materials.

Mathematics

This term in Maths, we will introduce students to fractions. Pupils will learn how to find fractions of an object, shape and quantity. Students will also learn how to represent and interpret data in tally charts, block graphs and pictograms. In the final two weeks, students will learn about Position and Direction.

Slovak / SAL

During this term we are devoted to the derivation of the letters of the Slovak alphabet. We focus on transcription of text and detailed analysis of words and determining the position of vowels in words. Through regular practice, pupils improve their writing technique. The main aim is to prepare pupils for the process of learning to read and write printed and written letters, syllables, words and sentences.

Art We will continue exploring the Visual Elements and learn about how to use Colour to express our feelings.

Forest School This term in forest school we storytelling and creating campfires. We will also be creating our own forest myths. Music The students will learn about a variety of instruments of the orchestra and learn how to recognise the sounds of

PSHE

This term, we will be learning more about emotions and how to cope with anger and with different strong emotions. Students will learn set 2 and 3 sounds from *Read Write Inc.* Students continue to read storybooks that are closely matched to their developing phonic knowledge. Pupils will identify characteristics of simple stories and pupils will read and explore a range of simple non-fiction text types.

This term, we will be participating in a wide range of skills such as team games that promote teamwork, hand to eye coordination, evasion skills and physical fitness. Students look forward to Sports Day when they can model their individual and cooperative sporting skills.

This term, our topic unit will be our world. During this unit, children will learn about the continents and the oceans of our planet, they will learn how to make, read and Interpret maps, and they will develop a deeper understanding regarding the uniqueness that each continent has to offer.
