Summer 1 + Summer 2

"What was life like in a castle?"

Why?

It's important to learn about castles because they teach us a lot about the past. Castles show how people lived long ago, how they built things, and how they protected themselves. By studying castles, we can understand how societies worked in olden times and how they changed over the years. Besides, exploring castles helps us appreciate our history and how it shaped the world we live in today.



Science

This term, children will explore materials and their properties. They will learn about common materials like wood, plastic, and metal through hands-on experiments, discovering properties such as hardness and flexibility. They will also learn about what a force is and start applying different forces to objects.

Mathematics

The first topic in this last term is Time. Students will learn the days of the week and months of the year before moving onto reading and writing times to the nearest 5 minutes on an analogue clock. We will then proceed with Money, Length and Height before finally reviewing larger topics such as addition and subtraction.

Slovak / SAL

During this period, we will continue to record speech graphically and gradually acquire good reading and writing skills. Pupils will continue to consolidate and automate their writing of all forms of the written and printed Slovak alphabet in syllables, words, sentences, transcription, copying and independent writing. They will improve their oral expression by telling short stories.

Art

We are continuing to explore the Visual Elements through Spring themed art and crafts.

Forest School

This term in forest school we storytelling and creating campfires. We will also be creating our own forest myths.

Music

Children will sing a range of the spring songs related to baby animals, growing and the new life. They will explore the instrument sounds in the project Carnival of the Animals.

English
