Autumn Term 2 March- April 2025 Year 4

Big Question - What do astronauts need for a successful journey in space and how can that benefit us on Earth?

English

We will be looking into fantasy story writing this term. The students will discover fantasy worlds full of mysterious characters and magical portals.

Mathematics

We will be looking at time converting between 12hr and 24hr time and investigating different timetables. In statistics, we will look at the best way to collect and present data. Lastly, we will look at fractions: finding different equivalents fractions and finding fractions of amounts.

Science

We will learn the names and features of planets in our solar system, about comets, asteroids, the rotation of the Earth and other things we can find in space.

Why?

We want to encourage children to be curious, ask questions, and investigate them. This is a key part of developing life-long learning skills. Few subjects create such an interest and awe as that of the Earth and space! This unit tries to build on children's imaginations whilst developing their knowledge of what's inside our own planet, and what the other planets in our solar system are like. They will then try to create their own fictional planet, using descriptive skills and scientific knowledge to make it seem authentic.

Topic
