Year 2

Autumn 2 Term

"Should dinosaurs be brought back from extinction?"

Why?

These incredible and fascinating creatures teach children more about how species come to be, disappear, adapt, and survive. An interest in dinosaurs also helps children understand the earth's timeline and appreciate that amazing things existed long before they did.



7 Weeks: November - December 2023

Science

This term, students will learn about light and the different sources that give light. Children will be able to talk about bright and dim sources and will be able to understand that darkness Is the absence of light. Moreover, children will be Introduced to the topic of electricity and will begin making simple electrical

Mathematics

This half term we will start skip counting as a pre-work on multiplication and division. We will expand our knowledge on Measurement by reviewing units of time and adding telling the time to o'clock and half past, as well as learning about length, tools to measure it and units. At the end of term, we will work with money and currency, using Euro and identifying different coins and notes.

Slovak language/ SAL

During this period, students expand their active vocabulary and use communication conventions appropriately. They improve their ability to identify the position of vowels in words and to analyse words in terms of their vowel sounds, thus consolidating their speaking skills. In the context of writing, they acquire skills in inferring the individual letters of the Slovak alphabet.
