Summer 1 + Summer 2

"What was life like in a castle?"

Why?

It's important to learn about castles because they teach us a lot about the past. Castles show how people lived long ago, how they built things, and how they protected themselves. By studying castles, we can understand how societies worked in olden times and how they changed over the years. Besides, exploring castles helps us appreciate our history and how it shaped the world we live in today.



12 Weeks: April - June 2024

Science

This term, children will explore materials and their properties. They will learn about common materials like wood, plastic, and metal through hands-on experiments, discovering properties such as hardness and flexibility. They will also learn about what a force is and start applying different forces to objects.

Mathematics

This last half term we are going to start by reviewing statistics and chance, continuing with money, currency, and amounts. We will learn how round up amounts while reviewing place value; 2-, 5- and 10-Times tables, and our last measuring unit: capacity. We will then proceed to review all our big units: fractions, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, and time.

Slovak / SAL

During this period we will continue to record speech graphically and gradually acquire good reading and writing skills. Pupils will continue to consolidate and automate their writing of all forms of the written and printed Slovak alphabet in syllables, words, sentences, transcription, copying and independent writing. They will improve their oral expression by telling short stories.

Art We are continuing to explore the Visual Elements through Spring themed art and crafts.

Forest School This term in forest school we storytelling and creating campfires. We will also be creating our own forest myths. Music Children will sing a range of the spring songs related to baby animals, growing and the new life. They will explore the instrument sounds in the project Carnival of the Animals.

PSHE

This term, we will be learning more about emotions and how to cope with anger and with different strong emotions. Students will learn set 2 and 3 sounds from *Read Write Inc.* Students continue to read storybooks that are closely matched to their developing phonic knowledge. Pupils will idenitify features of newspaper reports and have a go at writing their own. Students will also write descriptions of characters and settings from 'Where the Wild Things

This term, we will be participating in a wide range of skills such as team games that promote teamwork, hand to eye coordination, evasion skills and physical fitness. Students look forward to Sports Day when they can model their individual and cooperative sporting

This term, our topic unit will be castles. Children will learn about famous castles around the world, they will learn the main features of castles, they will get to enjoy a trip to a real castle, and finally, they will build their own castles after real examples using recycled materials.
