Year 2

Autumn 1 Term

"Should dinosaurs be brought back from extinction?"

Why?

These incredible and fascinating creatures teach children more about how species come to be, disappear, adapt, and survive. An interest in dinosaurs also helps children understand the earth's timeline and appreciate that amazing things existed long before they did.



6 Weeks: September - October 2023

Science

This term, students will learn about living things in their habitats. This will allow them to develop their vocabulary and their understanding of the different animals and plants living in some of the world's most popular habitats. Children will also learn about what animals need to stay alive and about animal offspring.

Mathematics

Students will start reviewing their prior knowledge on counting and expanding it to 100. We will continue learning how to add and subtract, as well as identifying 2D shapes and their properties. We will start working with data as an introduction to statistics and finish our term understanding and using units of time and

Slovak language / SAL

In this period we are very active in developing the fine motor skills of the students by writing preparatory exercises according to a pattern, improving oral expression by telling short stories. Aurally we distinguish syllables in a word, visually letters in a word, analyse vowels in syllables and in a word, determine the number of vowels and syllables.

Art We are going to learn about the **Visual Elements** through fun art and craft activities.

Forest School We will be focusing on some basic tool use and bushcraft skills. Learning to analyse risk in it's most simple form and and considering the benefits/consequences of

Music We are going to learn what is BEAT in music, how to keep a steady beat, and learn some rhythmic patterns using songs about dinosaurs.

PSHE

In PSHE, students will learn about the roles of different people In their lives, and about the relationships they develop with the people In their lives. We will also be setting expectations and routines for this school year.

This term, our topic unit is dinosaurs. Children will learn about the time periods when dinosaurs were alive, what they ate, what are some of their physical features, as well as why they went extinct.
