Autumn 1 Term

"What was life like in a castle?"

Why?

Learning about castles teaches us about the ways people lived in the past, about settlements and about how life has changed from the medieval times.



Science

In Science, students will be learning about types of materials, their purposes and their properties.

Mathematics

Students will start reviewing their prior knowledge on counting and expanding it to 100. We will continue learning how to add and subtract, as well as identifying shapes and their properties (2D and 3D). We will start working with data as an introduction to statistics and we will finish our term with time telling (half and

Slovak / SFF

Students will learn the initial sounds of the alphabet and how to divide a sentence into words and syllables. They actively expand their vocabulary and use the acquired information to practice their speaking and listening skills. They also improve their Slovak speaking skills by telling short stories. Students prepare their hands and fingers for writing. They will learn to distinguish vowels in words. Students become familiar with the graphic notation of speech. Using pictures and photos, students improve their Slovak speaking skills by talking about what they see.

Art

We are going to learn about the Visual Elements through fun art and craft activities.

Music

We are going to learn how to keep a steady beat using medieval music, songs about castles, and dance.

Forest School

This term we will be looking at learning through doing, teamwork, problem solving, nature appreciation, arts, bug hunts.

PSHE

In PSHE, students will learn about the roles of different people in their lives, and about the relationships they develop with the people in their lives.
