

Year 2

Autumn 2 Term

"What was life like in a castle?"

Why?

Learning about castles teaches us about the ways people lived in the past, about settlements and about how life has changed from the medieval times.



Science

In Science, students will be learning about different types of forces, their properties and how they affect and change our lives.

Mathematics

This half term students will review their skip counting skills in order to start multiplying and dividing by twos, fives and tens. Students will also work with time units and clocks, reading and recording time; and start measuring length in different ways.

Slovak / SFF

Year 2 students expand their active vocabulary and use communication conventions appropriately throughout this term. They improve their speaking skills by telling short stories. As part of writing, they acquire skills in deriving individual letters of the Slovak alphabet, learn printed and written forms of letters, and determine and analyse individual words into sounds.

Art

We are going to learn about the Visual Elements through seasonal art and craft activities.

Music

We are going to learn how to keep a steady beat using songs for our Christmas performance.

Forest School

This term we will be looking at learning through doing. Students will take what they have learned in the classroom and put it to practical use.

PSHE

In PSHE, students will learn about the importance of privacy and how to ask and seek consent. We will also continue looking at how our behaviours can affect others.

English

Over the next half term, students will learn new phonemes and graphemes to further their existing phonetic knowledge. Students will begin to read 'story books' that help all children learn to read fluently and at speed so they can focus on developing their skills in comprehension, vocabulary, and spelling.
