How can we improve our relationship with mountains?



English

We will begin with non-chronological reports. We will learn a range of techniques authors use to make information easy to understand. We will then use these to write reports on mountains. Following this, we will switch to looking at persuasion in the context of debating.

Mathematics

Our maths topics this half term are data and statistics; fractions, decimals and percentages; and probability.

Science

We will learn about the states of matter as well as properties of materials, including electrical and thermal conductivity. We will also look at reversible and irreversible changes.

Slovakia's main geographical feature are its mountains. From the High Tatras to the Little Carpathians, we have all visited these landforms at some point in our lives. This topic will give the children a deeper understanding and appreciation for mountains.

Midway through the term, we will also have a dedicated PBL week where year 6 will get the chance to work in groups with year 7 students.

Spanish

We will learn about likes and dislikes, the weather, sports and Spanish traditions as Christmas or the 3 Wise Men.

Art

We are going to concentrate on the Visual Element of Texture and create a collaborative Mountain Landscape.

Music

We are going to learn about different purposes of music such as ceremonial, recreational, and artistic.

ICT

We will learn about ways we can link information in documents and websites using hyperlinks.

German

We will revise the food topic, learn how to give directions and to explain where we live. We will learn a german

PSHE

We will have a whole school focus on bullying and ways the children can be proactive in preventing it in our school.
